Subject: **Multi-purpose Identification Cards of Citizens.**

I am directed to address you in the context of the multi-purpose identification cards of citizens proposed to be prepared by the Union Home Ministry. It has been observed that various departmental databases like that of elections, income tax, sales tax, banks, insurance, other utilities and various socio-economic databases such as Below Poverty Line databases cannot be interlinked without a common citizens' identification code. Creation of various databases in isolation without a clear perspective plan of its usage and continuous maintenance in future does not have much utility. Any database concerning citizens, property and businesses is feasible only when the database is properly validated for use across departments and the concerned Department has complete understanding of its use and future management. The departments should also have definite plans of action to utilize information to be gleaned from such citizens' database.

Accordingly, It has been decided that Electronics & Information Technology Department shall be consulted before preparing any database concerning citizens to coordinate the efforts of various departments and also to avoid multiplicity of efforts.
